

BTC COURT USAGE RULES

I. BTC COURT USAGE RULES FOR MEMBERS:

I-A. RULES GOVERNING MEMBERS' USE OF COURTS

1. Members may reserve a time slot for up to 1 1/2 hours of play on a court by marking their names on the calendar sign up sheet posted on the club bulletin board.
2. Members will forfeit a reserved time of play if they are not present at the club within 10 minutes of the schedule start time, except for unforeseen delays such as a delay caused by an accident on the freeway.
3. Members may sign up for a reserved time of play not more than seven (7) days in advance.
4. Members may not reserve more than 1 1/2 hours of consecutive court time. No member of a group playing during a reserved time slot may reserve an additional time slot on the same day until after the group has completed play.
5. Members may not reserve any court for individual practice (backboard, ball machine, serves, etc.).
6. Certain members have reserved weekly court times, which preceded the sign up procedures and are deemed grand-fathered ("Established Weekly Times"). The practice of granting new Established Weekly Times has been discontinued and no new times will be granted.
7. The Established Weekly Times shall be noted automatically on the sign up sheet with their times shaded.
8. Members who have Established Weekly Times shall notify the Board when this privilege is no longer needed.
9. Members who have Established Weekly Times are subject to cancellation due to inconsistent or non-use of court time, at the discretion of the board. Absent special circumstances, non-use for a period of one month will be cause for cancellation.

I-B. RULES GOVERNING GUEST USE OF COURTS

1. Members are responsible for registering guest players in the club folder located at the phone desk. Members should sign in their guests before starting play.
2. Guest fees of \$5 will be charged to the sponsoring member's account. The amount of the guest fee is subject to change in the discretion of the Board.
3. At the present time, there is no limit on the number of times a guest may play at the club during a particular month, in order to accommodate groups, which need substitutes. This policy is subject to change in the discretion of the Board.
4. Members will be subject to Board sanctions for abusing guest use rules or failing to sign in their guests. The board may authorize the club pro or other persons to sign in guests for members if the members fail to sign for his or her guest.

II. BTC COURT USAGE RULES FOR LEAGUE BTC TEAMS

1. Members may request the approval of the board to organize and captain league club teams. The request must be submitted in writing not less than 30 days before submission of the team's league application.
2. The team captains must be club members and shall be responsible for the following:
 - a. Posting the league's season notice and contact information on the club bulletin board as a courtesy to club members;
 - b. Requesting approval from the board for reserved court time not less than 30 days prior to submission of the team's league application for offering the use of the courts for league play;
 - c. Ensuring that a minimum of 50% club members or spouses will be on the roster and play during the season;
 - d. Payment of a \$100 team fee per league season, which shall be charged to the member captain's account;
 - e. Registering any non-member players as the member captain's guests for practice sessions held as the club, for which the member

captain will be billed accordingly, unless another member signs for such non-member player as his or her guest;

- f. Being present during team practices and matches (or designating another member to be present and accept responsibility for compliance with these rules);
 - g. Reserving sufficient parking spaces for club members during matches and practices and maintaining club lanai decorum; and
 - h. Ensuring that the players for the other team vacate the premises in a timely manner, after the match is completed.
3. Players from the other teams are not permitted to use the courts after the matches, unless a member signs for them as his or her guests and a member is on the court playing with them. The member signing for such players will be billed accordingly. Players from other teams are not permitted to use the club facilities other than the restrooms, or to have abusive post-match barbeques or extended drinking sessions on club premises.
4. League matches will generally be scheduled on Saturday between 12 noon and 5 pm and Sunday between 8 am and 12 noon.

THE BTC COURT USAGE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE IN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD. NO PERSON OR MEMBER SHALL HAVE ANY VESTED RIGHTS OR PLAYING PRIVILEGES UNDER THESE RULES.
